Inland Chorus reunion is Saturday

Folks who participated in the Inland Children's Chorus – from 1936 to 1970 – are gathering once again for an annual reunion. The event is slated for noon on Saturday at the MCL Banquet Room, 4485 Far Hills Ave.

The group is dedicated to preserving and making widely available the history and music of the chorus, an historically unique contribution by American industry to young people, the community, and the performing arts.

The group was sponsored by the Inland Manufacturing Division of General Motors Corporation to give 8- to 16-year-old children of employees "a musical education and training which they otherwise might not be able to obtain and to make a contribution to the cultural life of Inland employees and the community." Inland engaged Broadway theatrical designer and Tony Award nominee Raymond Sovey to stage the concerts. They often performed with the Dayton Philharmonic Orchestra and gained national acclaim on radio and television.
